Kathmandu valley is loaded with different amazing spots to let you have the superb experience of sightseeing tour. Places to visit in Kathmandu - you can start from the capital town, Kathmandu and walk around the artistic and glorious antique temples, shrines, stupas and more; most of which are enlisted in UNESCO World Heritage List. Especially, while going for Kathmandu sightseeing in the capital city, you will visit Kathmandu Durbar Square where you will get to see a series of shrines of the very old times including Hanuman Dhoka Palace, Kumari Ghar (Residence of Living Goddess) etc.

In addition, Kathmandu tourism - you will go around a major stupa of the valley lying at the hillock named Swayambhunath which is also referred as the monkey temple. It lets you catch the landscape of Kathmandu Valley from the top. It is worshiped by both followers of the Buddhism and the Hinduism. You may also make a trip to Pashupatinath, one of the holiest temples in Nepal and after that go around Boudhanath, the largest Buddhist stupa in the world.

You may also make a trip to Patan Durbar Square which is also enlisted in UNESCO World Heritage site. Here, you may travel around amazing Krishna Mandir, Mahabouddha, Hiaranya Varna Mahaa Vihar, Kumbeshwor Temple and a lot of other shrines loaded with amazing arts and wonderful carvings. The same glory of artistic beauty can be experienced while visiting Bhaktapur Durbar Square. At Bhaktapur Durbar Square you can go around 55 windows palace, golden gate, and more. In addition, from Bhaktapur, passing through farmlands and small villages, you may make a trip to Chagunarayan, the oldest holy place in the Kathmandu valley.
