Muktinath Tour is prepared whether you like to tour or Muktinath trek. It is worthful trekking tour even though road access there. Jomsom - Muktinath is a holy pilgrimage spot for both the Hindu and Buddhist followers. As you reach Muktinath located at the elevation of 3800m altitude in the north-central part of Nepal, you will notice the open space and rewarded by the eye-catching views of the wonderful Annapurna Himalayan peaks in Muktinath tour. The sacred place is also referred as a fraction of the 108 Vaishnava temples found in Muktinath temple. The direct Deluxe night bus has been started since 19.01.2017 from Jomsom to Kathmandu (leaves 12 Noon) and Kathmandu to Jomsom (Leaves 15:00).

Muktinath means "God of Salvation". This holy area lies in the dried out scenery in the rain shade of gigantic Himalayas. There are a lot of folklores about the holy place, Muktinath that was formed on its own amid seven others including Srirangam, Sri Mushnam, Tirupati, Thottadri, Pushkaram, Naimisaranyam, and Badrinath. The walls in the region hold 108 waterspouts. And, the Jwala Mai temple close by has an eternal fire burnt by natural gas.

You need to get to Jomsom to begin the Muktinath pilgrimage trekking/tour if you have tight timing. You can take up a flight from Pokhara which takes only 25 minutes from Pokhara. As you reach Jomsom you will be surrounded by the most stunning snowy peaks including Dhaulagiri, Tukuche, Nilgiri, and many other peaks. Also in Jomsom Muktinath tour, you see hot spring at Tatopani (Myagdi)beside the Kali Gandaki if you go via Beni. Moreover, you will get a chance to pick up the stones on the shore of Kali Gandaki which would be an interesting experience of the voyage. It is normal to hit upon 'Saligram' which means ammonite snail fossils. It is believed to be the sign of Lord Vishnu as per Hindu Mythology. Additionally, during the Muktinath pilgrimage trekking/tour, you can have adventurous hiking or even pony treks.

With Nepal Kailash Trekking, you can with no trouble to Muktinath. The trek will certainly reward you with the sight of the striking Annapurna and Dhaulagiri Himalayan ranges. Plus, when you will get to discover the vast open space then this special voyage to the Muktinath, which will be worthwhile.
